## Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF)

Post Completion Sign Requirement

A LWCF acknowledgement sign should remain displayed at the PROJECT site at a location where the public will see it, such as an entrance kiosk.

GRANTEES must replace signs at their own expense.

Examples of LWCF signs date from the original metal triangular plaque to the current sign. The LWCF sign requirement is met when the LWCF plaque or any of these signs is posted for the public to see.





Permission to use alternate language may be requested by submitting a mock-up showing the proposed appearance and language of the alternate sign.
