SUBJECT: Public Works Plan Update – Annual Reporting

Summary

From 2001-2018, reporting for the existing Coastal Development Permit (CDP) consisted of updates from State Parks as needed and an annual report prepared by the Technical Review Team (TRT) that reviewed specific CDP requirements, progress made on the requirements and reported annually to the Coastal Commission. The PWP will recommend the creation of an advisory group that would consist of stakeholders from various groups to assist in expanding community engagement and participate in the future developments of the park units.

Discussion

The State Parks and the Coastal Commission established the TRT with CDP A-4-82-300- A5 in 2001 to review management measures associated with the permit. The TRT met annually until 2018 and provided valuable insight on many scientific and management- related topics. State Parks and the Coastal Commission will continue to work collaboratively on coastal concerns.

Oceano Dunes District recognizes the value in receiving regular feedback from stakeholder advisory groups about park operations, visitor experience, access, and other issues. Instead of the TRT, the District would like to establish an advisory group to incorporate a range of topics important to visitors, residents, and others.

The District will engage stakeholders from across all platforms and invite members representing various stakeholder groups to participate in an

advisory capacity. In an advisory capacity, these stakeholders will join with others to provide background, perspective, and priorities from specific interests for consideration in such things as ongoing park operations, implementing projects, providing increased visitor services and public engagement. This group would meet regularly to review issues and make recommendations for District Superintendent consideration.

The OHMVR Commission and its meetings provide a valuable public forum to distribute information, discuss topics, and receive feedback on issues that affect Oceano Dunes SVRA. State Park staff will continue to provide information and updates about Oceano Dunes SVRA at future meetings.
