1. To ensure the health and safety of persons and property on lands administered by the Department of Parks and Recreation, Off Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division, Ocotillo Wells State Vehicular Recreation Area, the following restrictions are in effect:

No person shall possess any Glass Beverage Containers in any area of Ocotillo Wells SVRA that is not a camping area as defined in Title 14 CCR 4301(u);

Camping is defined as:

- 1) Erecting a tent or shelter or arranging bedding, or both, for purposes of, or in such a way as will permit, remaining overnight.
 - 2) Use of houseboats or boats for the purpose of sleeping during the nighttime hours, whether anchored, moored or beached.
 - 3) Use of any parked or standing vehicle for the purpose of sleeping during nighttime hours.
2. Exceptions to this order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Ocotillo Wells State Vehicular Recreation, 5172 Hwy 78 #10, Borrego Springs, CA. 92004.
 3. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.
 4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
