Special Events

The following activity is prohibited throughout Prairie City State Vehicular Recreation Area during and in the course of an approved Special Event:

- 1. No person may operate any motorized vehicle or equipment in violation of the terms and conditions of the Special Event except as follows:
 - A. Employees and volunteers of the State of California.
 - B. Employees and volunteers of the permittee as authorized by the Special Event agreement.

Vehicles covered by this order shall include mopeds, motorized bicycles, golf carts, motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles, recreational utility vehicles, or any other off-highway vehicle.

2. No person may violate any term or condition of an authorized Special Event Permit.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Gold Fields District Superintendent or designee at 7806 Folsom-Auburn Road, Folsom, CA 95630.
