PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The General Plan outlines goals and guidelines that apply to the entire Clay Pit SVRA. These goals and guidelines address existing issues and provide ongoing guidance to management. This plan describes a long-term vision for Clay Pit SVRA to provide a convenient place for friends, families, and groups to enjoy the outdoor recreational setting through OHV activity and other compatible recreational uses. In addition the OHMVR Division approved improvements to provide park facilities related to administration, maintenance and operations in the near term. Near-term facility improvements include park infrastructure such as an entrance station, maintenance facility and staff station, and associated upgrading of utilities and roads.

This is to advise that the California Department of Parks and Recreation, OHMVR Division, as lead agency, has approved the above project on June 23, 2012 and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
