



BCSW #7. Grasshopper Trail Camp.
This camp would be located near Grasshopper Peak and is situated between Grieg Road and the proposed Grasshopper Saddle Trail.

BCSW #2. Proposed Grasshopper Saddle Trail.
Develop the new Grasshopper Saddle Trail to connect the proposed Johnson Camp Crossover Trail to the South Prairie Trail and provide a non-road alternative to Grasshopper and Grieg roads for hiking, bicycling, and horseback riding.

BCSW #3. Proposed Upper Gould Barn Trail.
Develop new Upper Gould Barn Trail to provide a non-road alternative connection from Bull Creek Trail Camp to the South Prairie Trail and/or the Grieg Road for hiking, bicycling, and horseback riding.

BCSW #8. Upper Gould Trail Camp.
This camp would be located at the site of the former Bull Creek Ranch and along the proposed Upper Gould Barn Trail.

BCSW #5. South Prairie Trail-1.
Modify trail to make it sustainable for bicyclists and change the designated uses to allow bikes.

BCSW #6. Panther Gap Rd.
Reconstruct existing non-system route on park property to improve vehicle administrative and emergency access. Trail use designation will be: hike, bike, horse.

BCSW #4. Weott Water System Rd.
Work with Weott Community Services District to increase maintenance frequency and resurface with coarse aggregate on a regular cycle to maintain firmness to insure continued access by easement holders.

Proposed trail alignments do not intersect. (see white dashed line)
