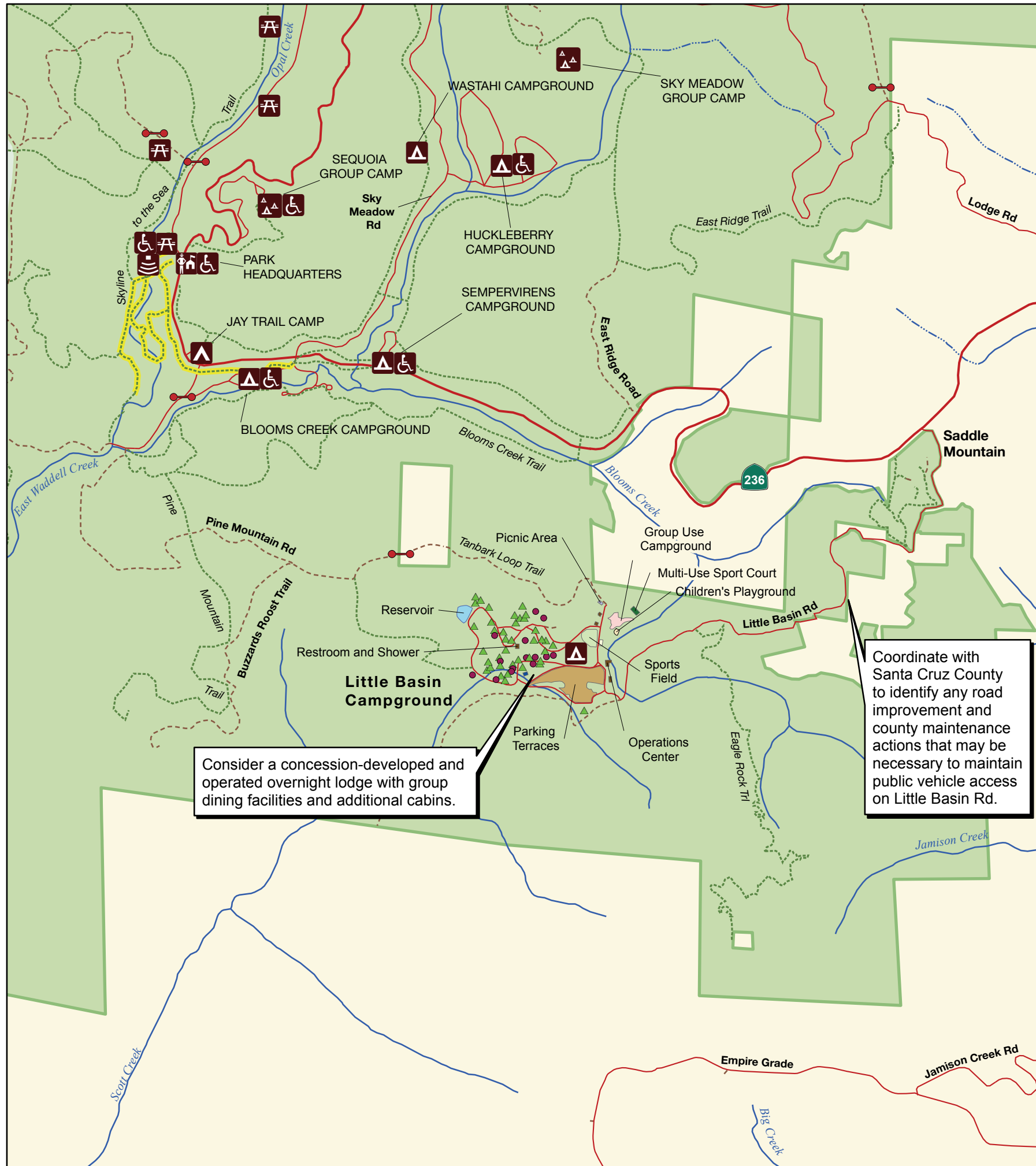


BIG BASIN REDWOODS STATE PARK DRAFT GENERAL PLAN PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE LITTLE BASIN

LITTLE BASIN GOALS

- Management intent is to establish and maintain a public day use and overnight recreation area for group use, and destination for special events.
- Upgrade and expand utility systems and infrastructure to support recreational activities, such as camping (including cabins), hiking, biking, horseback riding, fishing, interpretive and group activities. Consider program needs for possible environmental education.
- Upgrade and/or modify the group picnic facilities and amphitheater in order to satisfy operational needs and meet ADA accessibility requirements.
- Complete inventories and resource evaluations, and implement resource protection measures. Remove or relocate existing modern facilities, as necessary, to preserve and protect sensitive natural resources and significant cultural resources.
- Interpret resource values, site history and past use of Little Basin (e.g. Hewlett-Packard Corp).



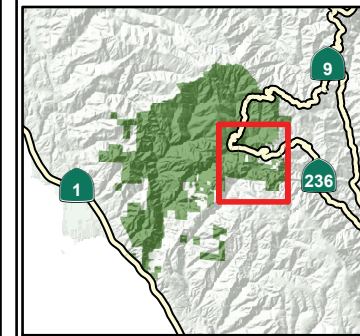
Consider a concession-developed and operated overnight lodge with group dining facilities and additional cabins.

Coordinate with Santa Cruz County to identify any road improvement and county maintenance actions that may be necessary to maintain public vehicle access on Little Basin Rd.
