California State Parks is preparing a General Plan (GP) and accompanying Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the California Indian Heritage Center (CIHC). The CIHC will be located on the East Riverfront Property in the City of West Sacramento. The GP will guide future development and management of the property. The planning team has developed a set of alternatives for site development and management and is looking for community input in reviewing and refining the alternatives. The alternatives will be presented to interested parties at the second public meeting held in support of the GP.
