**Farm manager's home and flume, 1920.**

**Franklin Point shipwrecks, 1865 and 1867.**

**Prehistoric archaeological sites.** Fragile sites exist throughout Año Nuevo State Park.

**Lumber wharf, 1864 (site).**

**Año Nuevo Light Station, 1872 -1948.**

**Dickerman dairy ranch, 1880.** Dairy barn, house, horse barn, creamery, and milk room. Structures are currently used for interpretation and staff residence.

**Ocean Shore Railway Company. Work camp site, 1904-1906.**

**Portola Expedition, 1769.** Several ill soldiers recover.

**Steele "back ranch" c. 1868 (site).**

**Quiroste village of Casa Grande (site).** Portolá expedition campsite, 1769.

**Cascade Ranch, 1862.** Steele house, Steele / Humphrey house (2 staff residences), cottage, horse barn, cemetery and Cascade Falls.

**Sawmill, 1870s (site).**

**Prehistoric Ohlone trails and late 1800s stage routes followed ridges.**
