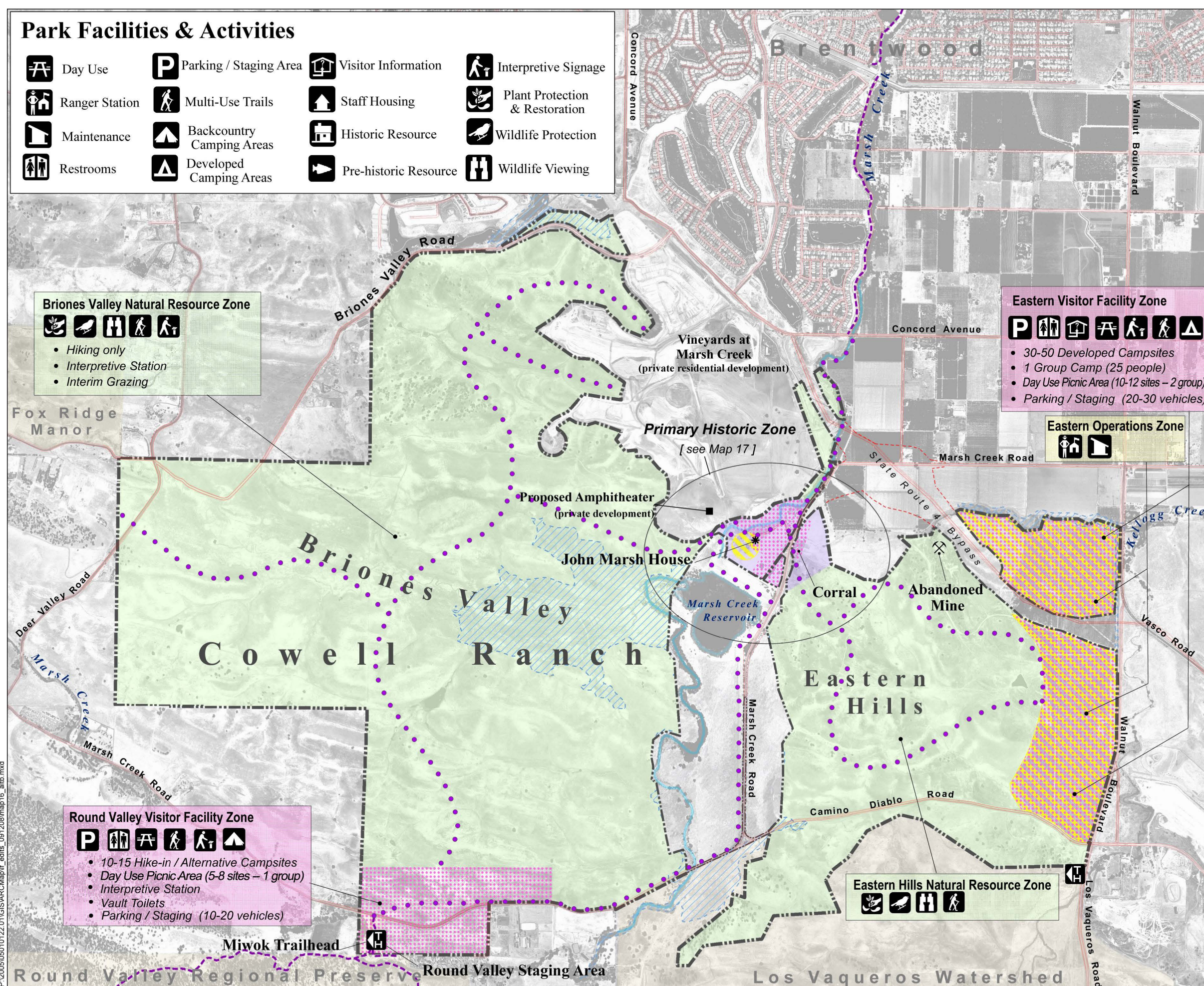

Briones Valley Natural Resource Zone

- Hiking only
- Interpretive Station
- Interim Grazing

Eastern Visitor Facility Zone

- 30-50 Developed Campsites
- 1 Group Camp (25 people)
- Day Use Picnic Area (10-12 sites – 2 group)
- Parking / Staging (20-30 vehicles)

Eastern Operations Zone

Round Valley Visitor Facility Zone

- 10-15 Hike-in / Alternative Campsites
- Day Use Picnic Area (5-8 sites – 1 group)
- Interpretive Station
- Vault Toilets
- Parking / Staging (10-20 vehicles)

Eastern Hills Natural Resource Zone

- Operations Zone
 - Historic Area Eastern
 - Visitor Facility Zone Eastern
 - Operations and Visitor Facility Zones Overlap
 - Primary Historic Zone
 - Natural Resource Zone Eastern Hills Briones Valley
