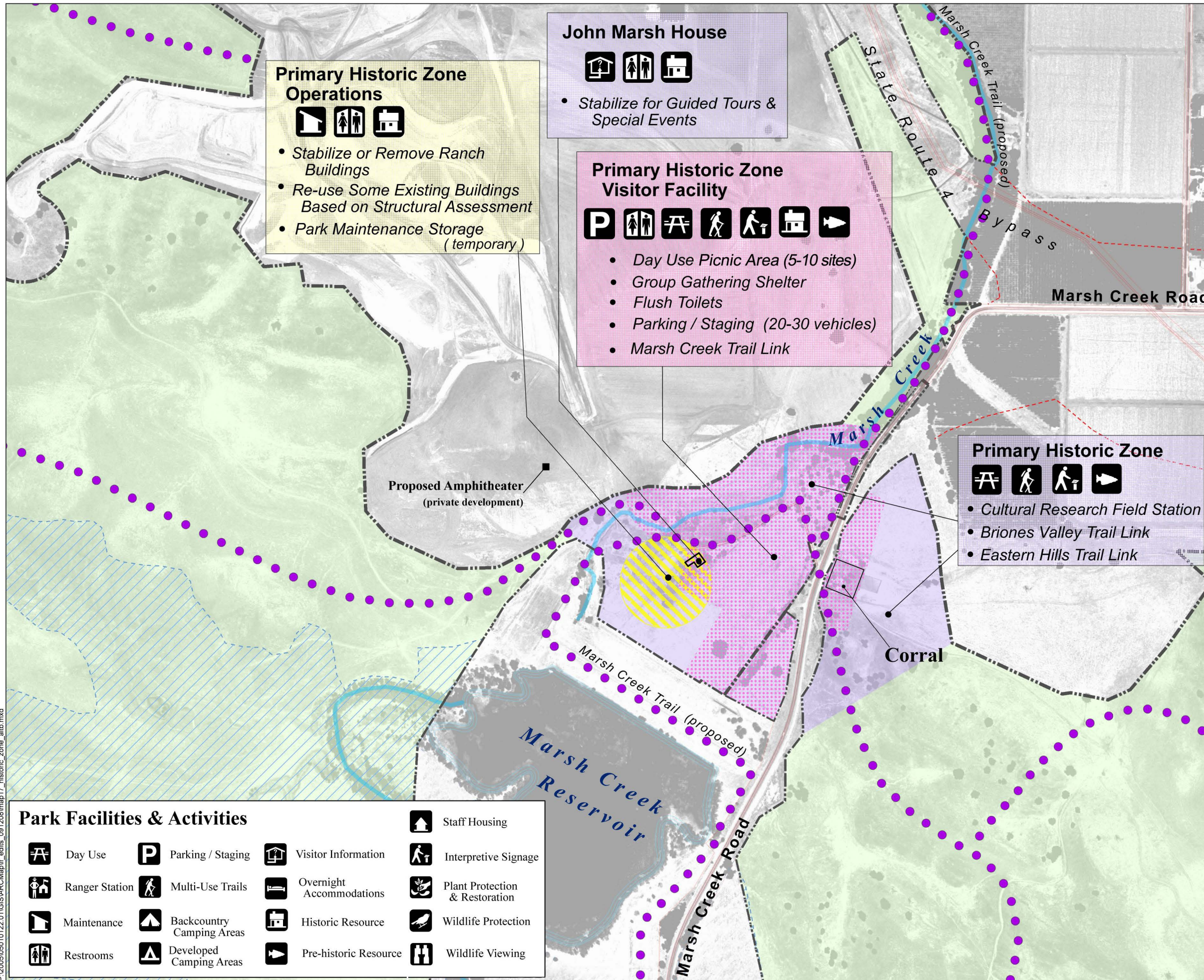

Primary Historic Zone Operations

- Stabilize or Remove Ranch Buildings
- Re-use Some Existing Buildings Based on Structural Assessment
- Park Maintenance Storage (temporary)

- Stabilize for Guided Tours & Special Events

Primary Historic Zone Visitor Facility

- Day Use Picnic Area (5-10 sites)
- Group Gathering Shelter
- Flush Toilets
- Parking / Staging (20-30 vehicles)
- Marsh Creek Trail Link

- Cultural Research Field Station
- Briones Valley Trail Link
- Eastern Hills Trail Link
