

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND INTENT TO ADOPT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR THE PROPOSED MILLERTON LAKE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN/GENERAL PLAN (RMP/GP) PROJECT

To: All Interested Agencies, Organizations, and Persons

The California Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) has directed the preparation of and intends to adopt an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Millerton Lake Resource Management Plan/General Plan (RMP/GP), in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and State CEQA Guidelines. DPR is the lead agency for the proposed project under CEQA.

PROJECT LOCATION: Millerton Lake Resource Management Plan/General Plan (RMP/GP), Millerton Lake in Madera and Fresno Counties

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED PROJECT: The Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation), as the National Environmental Policy Act Federal lead agency, and the California Department of Parks & Recreation (CDPR), as the California Environmental Quality Act State lead agency, have made available for public review and comment the Millerton Lake draft RMP/GP and EIS/EIR. The draft RMP/GP and EIS/EIR describes and presents the environmental effects of the No-Action Alternative and three (3) Action Alternatives. A public hearing will be held to receive comments from individuals and organizations on the draft RMP/GP and EIS/EIR.
