Project Location: Crystal Cove State Park

Project Description: The project proposes to adopt and implement the Crystal Cove Historic District *Preservation and Public Use Plan*. This plan requires a General Plan Amendment to the Crystal Cove State Park General Plan. The plan proposes a range of uses for the Historic District and adjoining areas that include long-term goals and guidelines for the appropriate types, locations, and designs of facilities that may be proposed in the future as well as specific proposals that will be implemented with current or near-term funding. The proposed uses include park operations (visitor center, kiosk, restrooms, offices, maintenance, staff housing), overnight accommodations, utility upgrades, and educational or interpretive facilities. These uses will be in conformance with the Department's policies for adaptive use in a Historic District. The plan will also establish interpretive programs and activities proposed or approved by the Department.

The California Department of Parks and Recreation has approved the project, and has made the following determinations regarding the project:

The California Department of Parks and Recreation has reviewed the final EIR, and certifies that it has been prepared in conformance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act, and in approving the project, has made the following determinations regarding the project:

- 1 The project will not have a significant effect on the environment after mitigation.
 The project will have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2 A Negative Declaration was prepared pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
 A Final Environmental Impact Report has been completed in compliance with CEQA, and has been presented to the decision-making body of this Department for its independent review and consideration of the information contained in the Final EIR prior to approval of the project.
- 3 Mitigation measures were were not made conditions of project approval.

4 A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for this project.

5 Findings were were not made on environmental effects of the project.
