*Written Comments Recorded:*

*(Northwest Area/Middle Peak)*

- North Horse Camp
- Park or private shuttle to gravity fed trails
- I’m concerned that solid science is not behind the efforts to accelerate reforestation via interventions with heavy machinery
- Bike camp
- Improve Kelley Ditch Trail to Heise Park
- Don’t reduce free parking areas like Sweetwater Bridge, thanks!
- More multiuse single-track trails

*(Lake Cuyamaca Area)*

- Protect stream and lake water quality

- Fix swamp raise it

*(Tulloch Area)*

- Hiking, biking, riding around north of lake is problematic, trail continuation for a loop
- Open new acquisitions more fully
- Open Tulloch to primitive eq camping

*(Lucky 5 Area)*

- Is there a Bike connection to Anza Borrego?
- Bike camp
- We need northern horse camp

*(Vaqueros/Stonewall/Northeast Area)*

- Do not take visitors out of beautiful areas to save something hidden under brush
- This works for parking
- Family horsecamp in north end of park, Yes!!
- Trail access for mountain bikers on Stonewall Peak
- Re-open Los Cab
- Bike only trails
- Preserve existing trails – don't close them – connect things – that will distribute traffic
- More equestrian camping/parking
- Equestrian camp (family) Los Vaq north
- Horse camp
- South end equestrian camp

*(Visitor Center/Green Valley Area)*

- Paved bike lanes on both sides of hwy 79 into Julian, Descanso, and Mt Laguna
- Staging. Parking horse
- Single track trail from green valley to La Cima. Multi Use

- Bikers help maintain trails
- More horse facilities
- Horse trailer parking (pullout area just north of Green Valley)
- Bike only trails
- Bike, camp, wash station, tool stand, cabins
- More horse trailer parking
- No fees at sweetwater bridge/parking (2)
- We need trails that keep me off roads – I am a father of two beautiful kids – don't need to be hit by a car
- Archaeology items are now well hidden by shrubbery – no need to close areas
- Trails should default to multi use except where scientifically proven they cannot support a given user group

*(Paso Picacho Campground Area)*

- Keep existing campground open year round. Concentrate on making each site safe and opened

*(Hual-cu-cuish Area)*

- Perm day use
- Day camp

*(Southeast/East Mesa Area)*

- Concern over parking fees at sweetwater, our taxes pay for park
- No fees
- Build rain yurts/huts when needed – not to waste federal money
- Why not both, bikes on odd days, horses on even days. If you are tolerant as a horse man, you can ride both
- Fix all deferred maintenance on park buildings
- We can share the park with Native Americans without insulting them
- Oakzanita trail bike access

- Trail access for mountain bikers on upper descanso trail
- Trail access to bikes
- No more stunts please! Keep trails natural

*(Green Valley Campground Area)*

- Trail access for mountain bikers on Monument Trail
- Mountain bike access
- Sweetwater multi use
- More horse trails
- Fly traps in horse camp. Keep it open longer, better grading for sites, level = good for rigs
- Use trail machine throughout park
- More horse trail access by Green Valley
- More shade for horses at green valley falls
- Green valley falls should stay open all year for camping
- Water access for 25ft hoses at green valley horse camp
- Cabins at green valley like paso

*(Highway 79 / South Park Entrance)*

- We would love an arrow on the left side of the CRSP sign as our property is in front of the sign and people regularly come in to camp!

*(Southwest/Merigan/Mack Area)*

- Equestrian camp
- N. end equestrian camp
- Fix wilderness boundary so mountain bike can access south end
- Sell (pos) annual pass at parking lot
- POS electronic payment parking fee
- Need horse camp here at merigan

- Limited horse camp no equestrian facility next to school
- Expand watershed wilderness
- Car to dispose of horse manure
- Need more horse facilities
- Parking fees have limited use of this parking area
- Open Mack to public and trails to park
