THE NEXT STEPS

- 1. California State Parks must complete the Tolowa Dunes State Park **Resources Summary and Reclassification** document. Public input and any further resource evaluation and recreation assessments will be used to finalize the State Park's formal proposal to the State Park and Recreation Commission (SPRC).
- 2. SPRC can approve the reclassification of this area to a **State Recreation Area** (SRA) if they find that hunting (same as previously managed) would not threaten the safety and welfare of other SRA users.
- 3. Subsequent actions by the Department to resume hunting would include:
 - a. Compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and
 - b. **Adopt regulations** and coordination with Department of Fish and Game for managing hunting activities.
- 4. A future **General Plan** for the State Park and potential SRA area is needed to comprehensively address long-term management and sustainability of land uses, resource protection and recreation opportunities. Potential funding is being considered for the preparation of a general plan.
