

## ***THE NEXT STEPS***

1. California State Parks must complete the Tolowa Dunes State Park **Resources Summary and Reclassification** document. Public input and any further resource evaluation and recreation assessments will be used to finalize the State Park's formal proposal to the State Park and Recreation Commission (SPRC).
2. SPRC can approve the reclassification of this area to a **State Recreation Area (SRA)** if they find that hunting (same as previously managed) would not threaten the safety and welfare of other SRA users.
3. Subsequent actions by the Department to resume hunting would include:
  - a. Compliance with the **California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)**, and
  - b. **Adopt regulations** and coordination with Department of Fish and Game for managing hunting activities.
4. A future **General Plan** for the State Park and potential SRA area is needed to comprehensively address long-term management and sustainability of land uses, resource protection and recreation opportunities. Potential funding is being considered for the preparation of a general plan.
