California State Parks Announces Concession Opportunity at Lake Perris State Recreation Area

PERRIS, Calif.—California State Parks is accepting proposals for a concession contract for the operation of the marina and related facilities at Lake Perris State Recreation Area (SRA) in Riverside County. A meeting is scheduled at 10 a.m. on Jun. 5, 2019 at the Lakeview Pavilion in Perris to learn more about the opportunity followed by a tour of the facilities.

The marina operation includes dock facilities, a camp store, restaurant, and several other opportunities. Lake Perris SRA provides many opportunities for recreation, including hiking, bicycling, fishing, swimming, picnicking, camping, rock climbing, and horseback riding, and visiting the Ya'i Heki' Regional Indian Museum.
