Old Town San Diego State Historic Park Announces Concession Opportunity For Historic Retail Store

SAN DIEGO, Calif. — The California Department of Parks and Recreation (State Parks) is accepting proposals from businesses to provide operations for historic retail store services to visitors at Old Town San Diego State Historic Park (OTSDSHP) in San Diego.

Proposals will be accepted from April 5 through June 17, 2024, for a 5-year concession contract, with a department option to extend the term an additional five years, for the operation of historic retail store services for the public.
