California State Parks Seeks Public Input on Concession at Silver Strand State Beach

CORONADO, Calif. — California State Parks is seeking public input on the future of the camp supply and food service concession located within Silver Strand State Beach (SB). An open house site visit is set at 4:30 p.m. on Feb. 20, 2019 at Silver Strand SB followed by a public meeting at 6:00 p.m. at the Crown Cove Aquatic Center in Coronado, parking fees for parking lot 3 will be waived.

State Parks plans to issue a Request for Proposals for a new concession contract through a competitive bid process for this concession. Input from the public meeting will aid officials in planning the future facilities and operations.

Silver Strand SB is located 12 miles south of San Diego and four and a half miles south of the Coronado. The park is located on the sand-pit that forms the outer edge of San Diego Bay between Coronado and Imperial Beach. Recreational activities in this popular park include camping, fishing, swimming, surfing, boating, water-skiing, volleyball, and picnicking.
