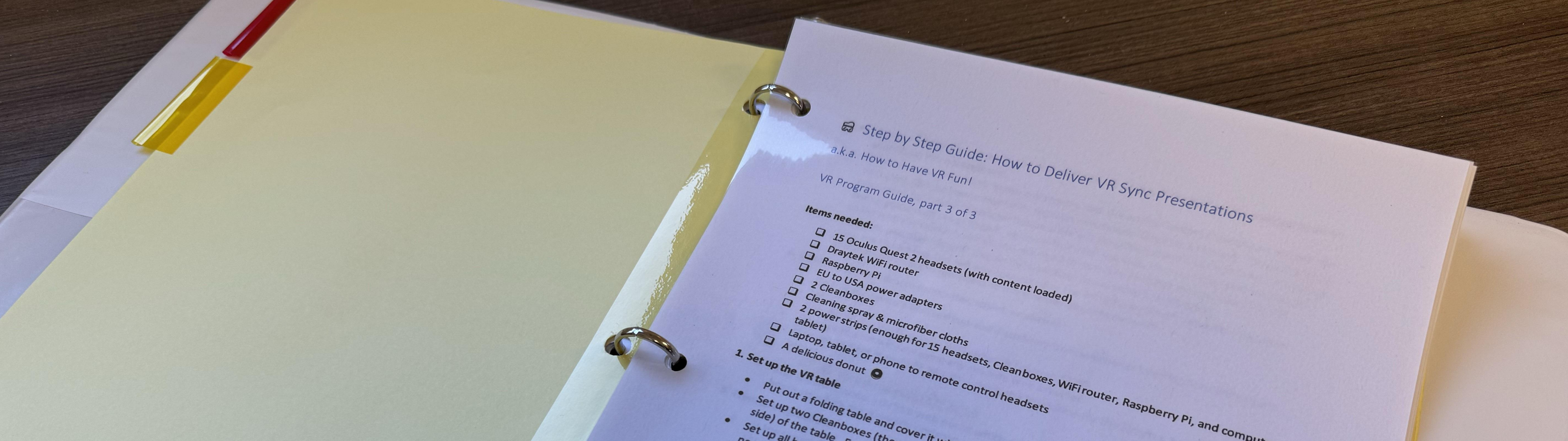

Step by Step Guide: How to Deliver VR Sync Presentations

VR Program Guide, part 3 of 3

**Items needed:**

- 15 Oculus Quest 2 headsets (with content loaded)
  - Draytek WiFi router
  - Raspberry Pi
  - EU to USA power adapters
  - 2 Cleanboxes
  - Cleaning spray & microfiber cloths
  - 2 power strips (enough for 15 headsets, Cleanboxes, WiFi router, Raspberry Pi, and computer tablet)
  - Laptop, tablet, or phone to remote control headsets
  - A delicious donut 🍩
- 1. Set up the VR table**
- Put out a folding table and cover it with a clean cloth
  - Set up two Cleanboxes (the side) of the table. For each Cleanbox, place a power strip on the side of the table.
  - Set up all headsets on the table.
