Butterfield Stagecoach Background

In 1857, John Butterfield was awarded a contract by the United States Postal Service to be the first overland mail route connecting the Eastern US to the new West. The 2,800 mile route began in St. Louis and had 137 stops until it reached its final destination in San Francisco. Every 20 miles the coaches and horses were changed—they had 25 days to get the mail run completed. The coaches operated from 1858-1861.
