## **Missions**

Missions were centers of religion and economy. That means you could buy and sell things in missions. The Franciscan Friars who ran the missions taught California Indians many different skills like farming and blacksmithing.

Presidios were military establishments. They were created to help protect missions from foreign invaders.

## **Pueblos**

Pueblos were like a small town square area. There would usually be a church, government buildings, and important homes around a rectangular plaza area.
