## Shoreline Trail China Camp State Park

The Shoreline trail is a 1.5 mile trail that is very popular with hikers and cyclists alike. There are small seasonal streams that run downhill at nearly every turn. The trail itself is fairly level making it ideal for all levels of hiking fitness. Nature enthusiasts will enjoy the grassy meadows and the mixed woods which consist of madrone, coast live, black oak, California Bay and buckeye. In late winter, wildflowers such as milkmaids and shooting stars grow in the various grassy spots along the trail. Be aware of poison oak. There are small amounts of it at head level in some areas of the trail.
