This notice relates to a possible authorization from the State Public Works Board to acquire a 2.28 acre parcel that is an in-holding to Marshall Gold Discovery SHP. Marshall Gold Discovery SHP is the historic core of the Town of Coloma and includes many historic structures. *Update: The State Public Works Board authorized the acquisition on March 14, 2008; the Department of Parks and Recreation acquired the property on April 3, 2008.*

Bond Section providing funding: Public Resources Code Section 75063(a)

The proposed acquisition satisfies the criteria of PRC Section 75063, subsection (a), because the property will contribute to the historic landscape and interpretive value of the surrounding park lands. Nearly all of the ground in this portion of Coloma contains cultural artifacts and DPR is interested in acquiring this property to prevent any potential development and for the preservation of its historical and cultural value.

Fulfillment of PRC Section 75071:

This project is being undertaken for its historic and cultural values. As this project was selected based on its historic and cultural priorities and has only ancillary natural resource benefits, it was not selected on the basis of natural resource characteristics outlined in Public Resources Code Section 75071(a) through (e).
