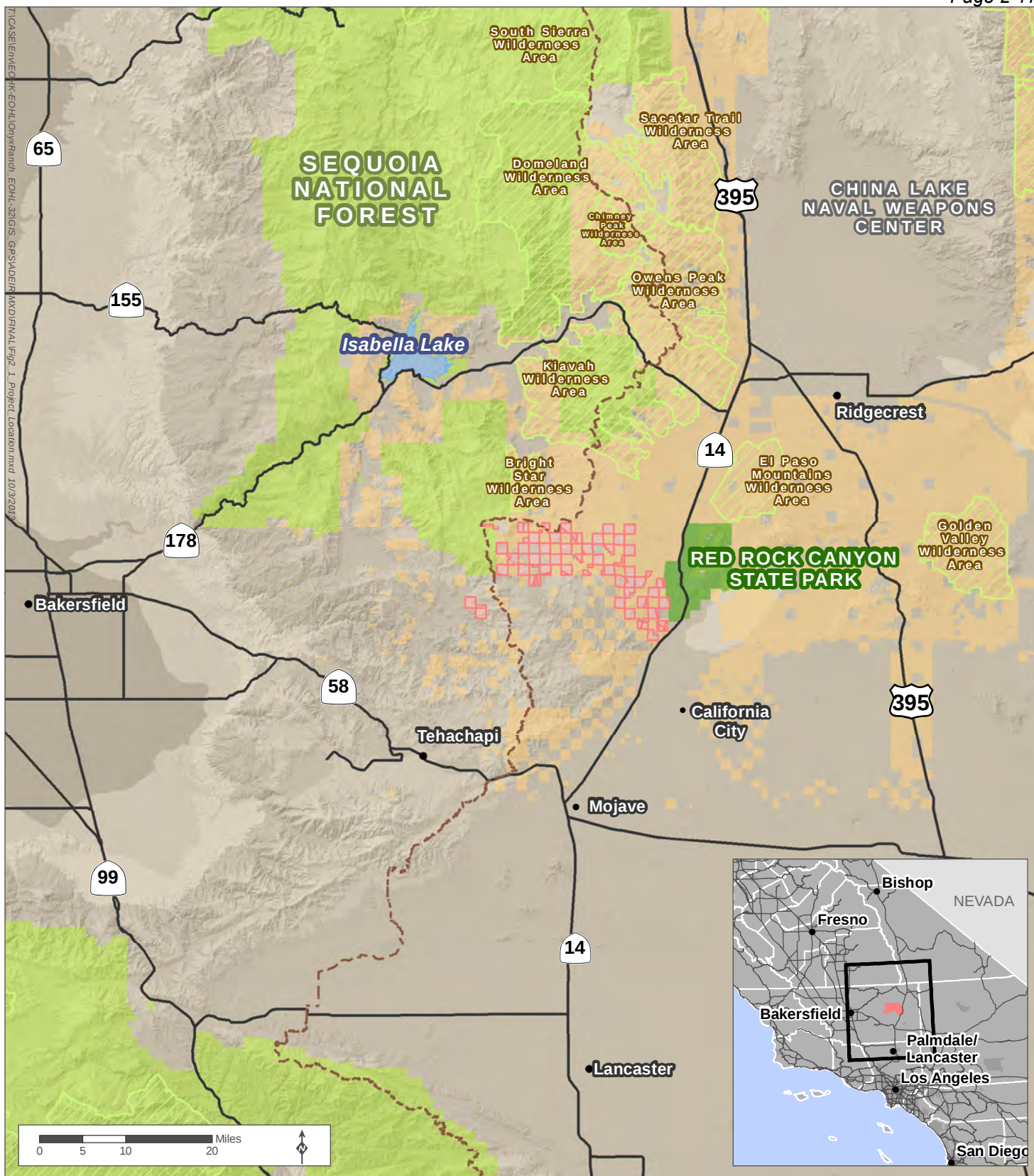


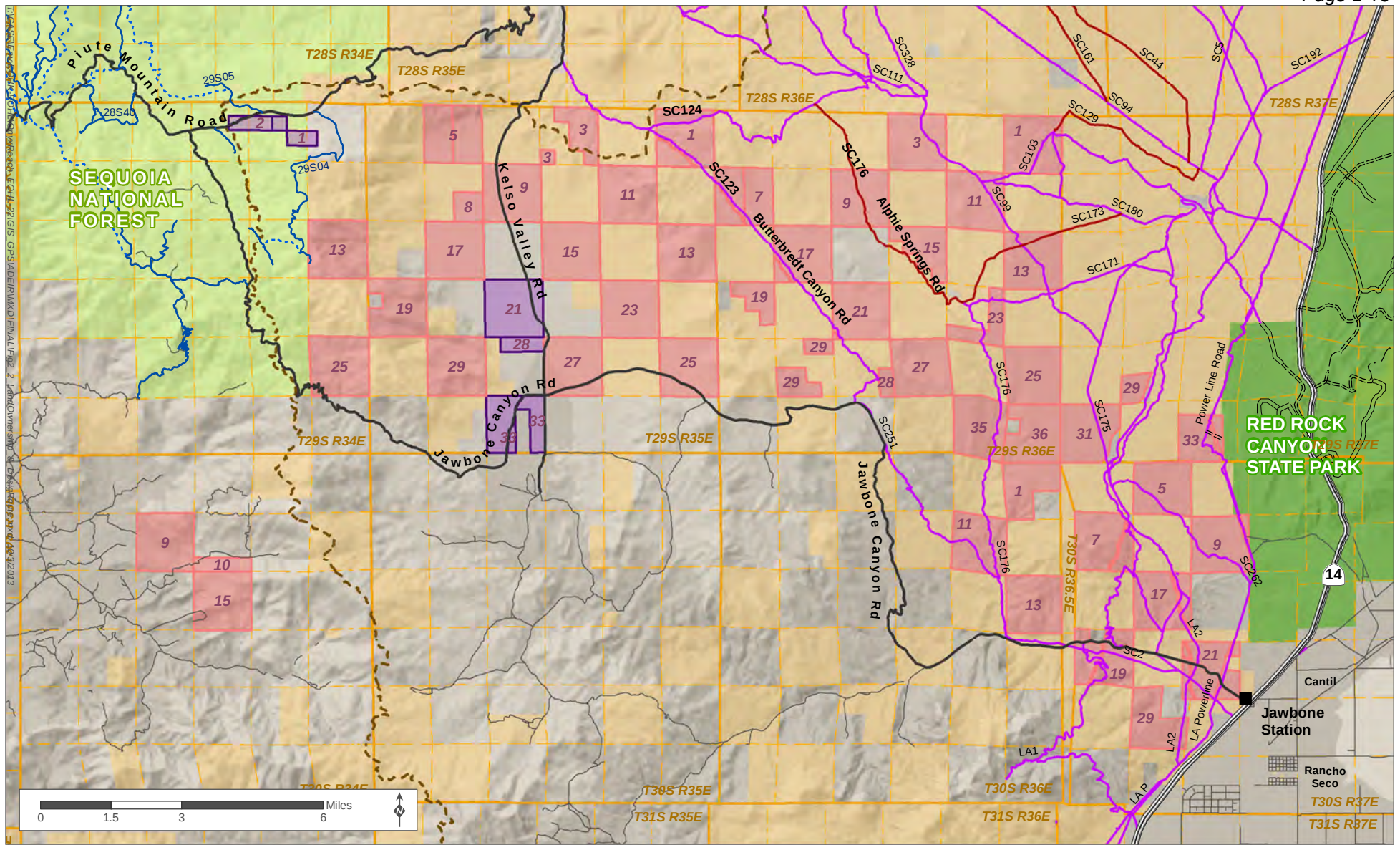

Figure 2-1 Project Location

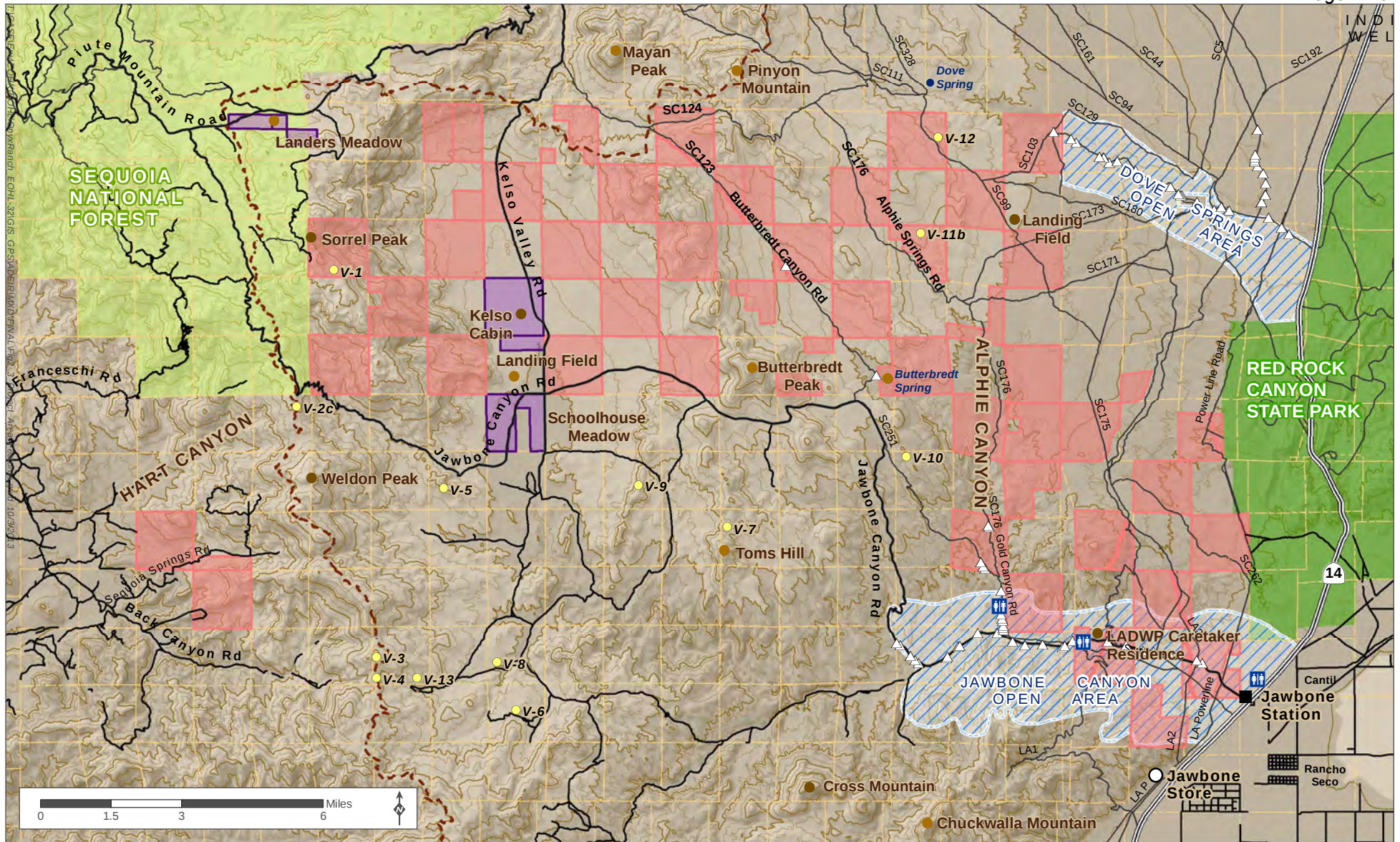

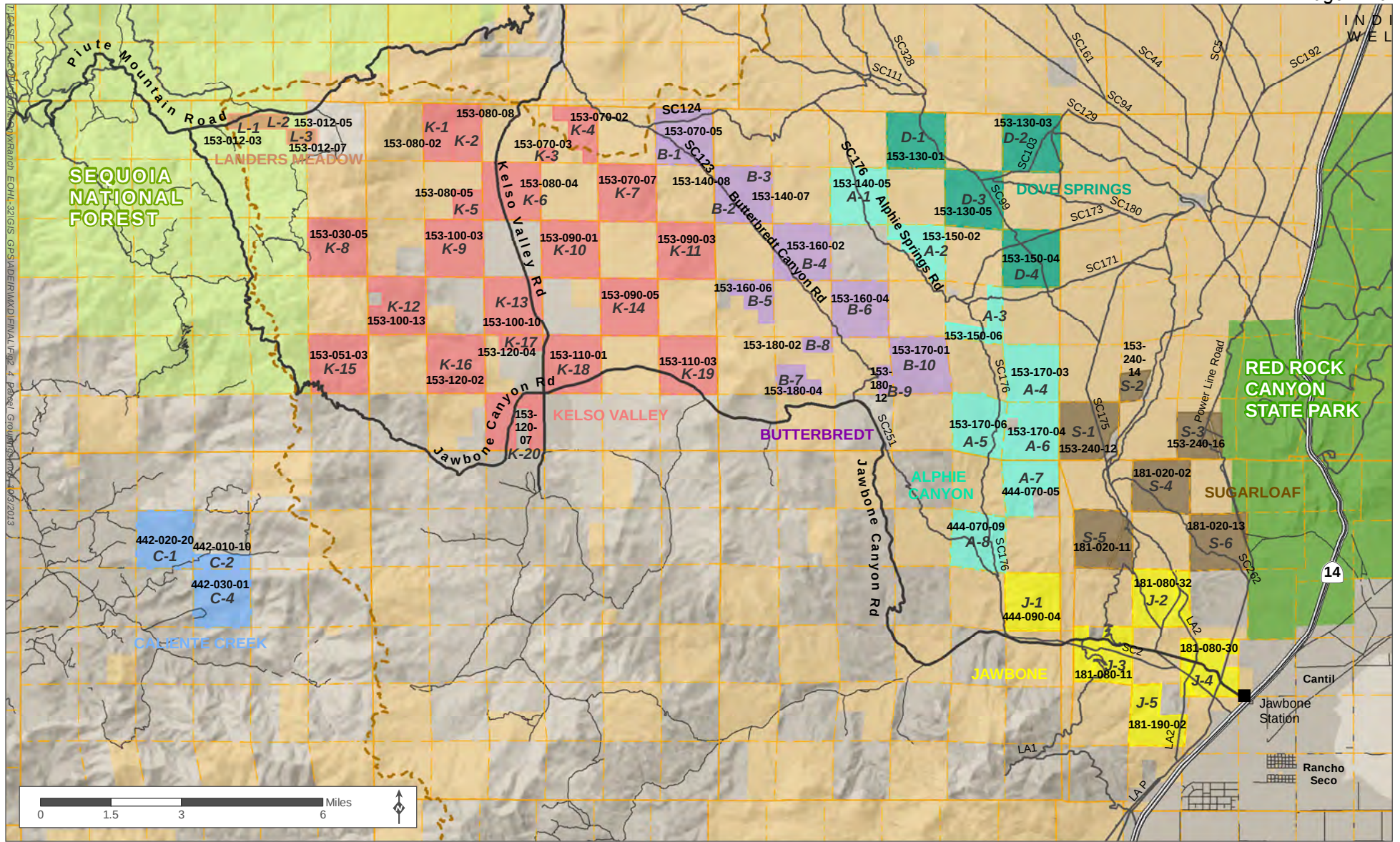

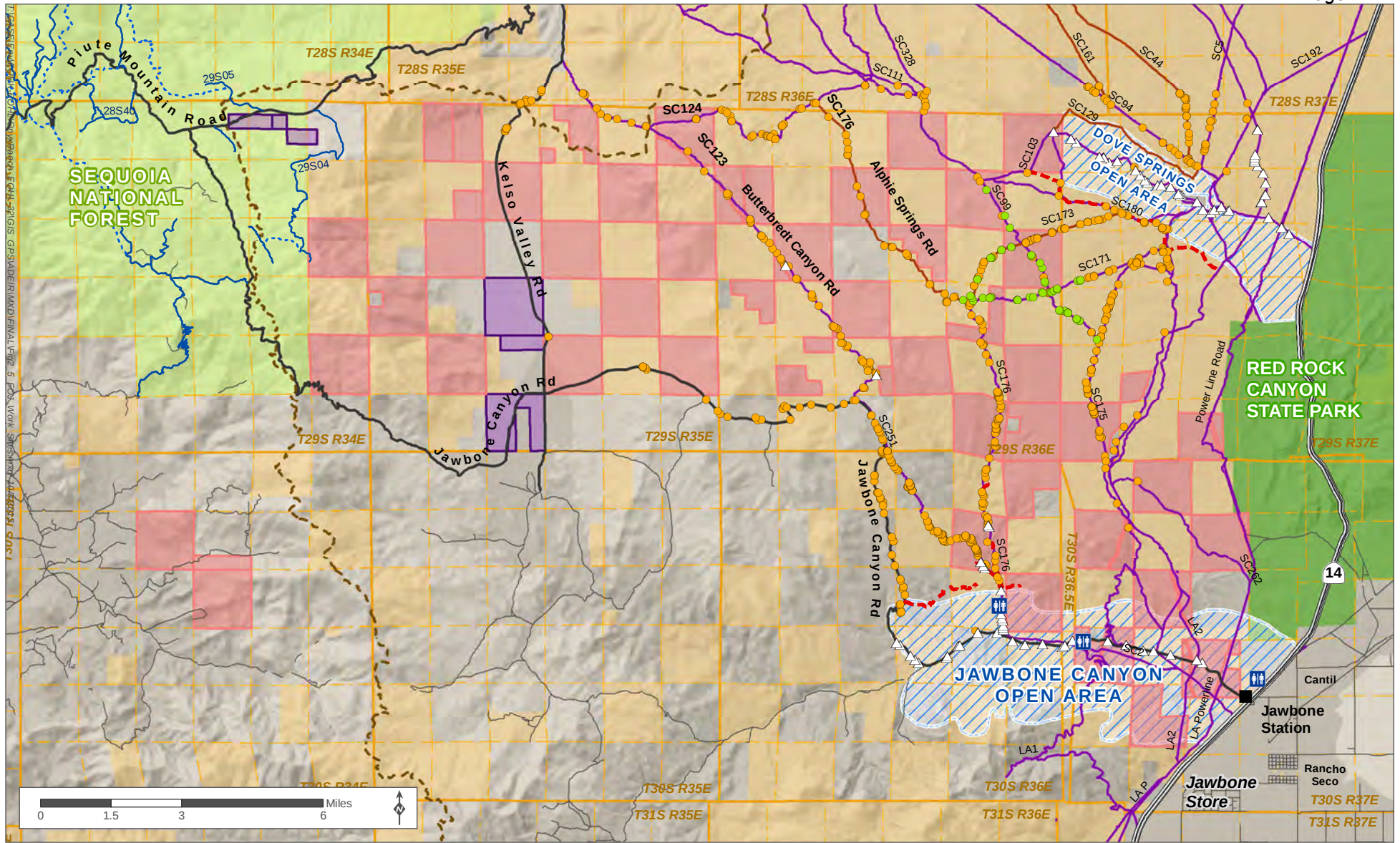
