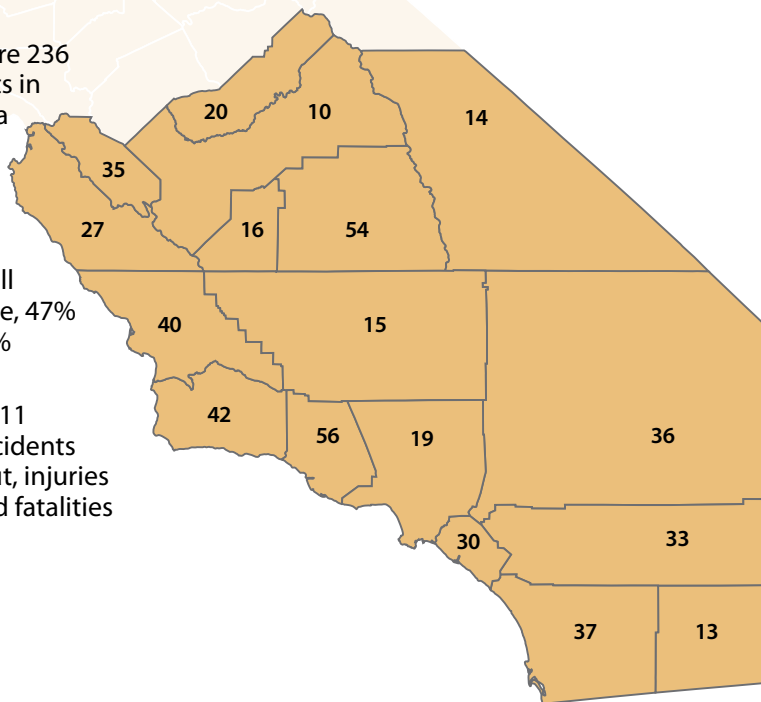


2011 California Recreational Boating Accident General Statistics for Southern California

In 2011, there were 236 boating accidents in Southern California that resulted in 146 injuries and 27 fatalities.

These accidents represent 46% of all accidents statewide, 47% of injuries, and 50% of fatalities.

Compared with 2011 accident totals, accidents decreased 16%, but, injuries increased 45%; and fatalities increased 17%.

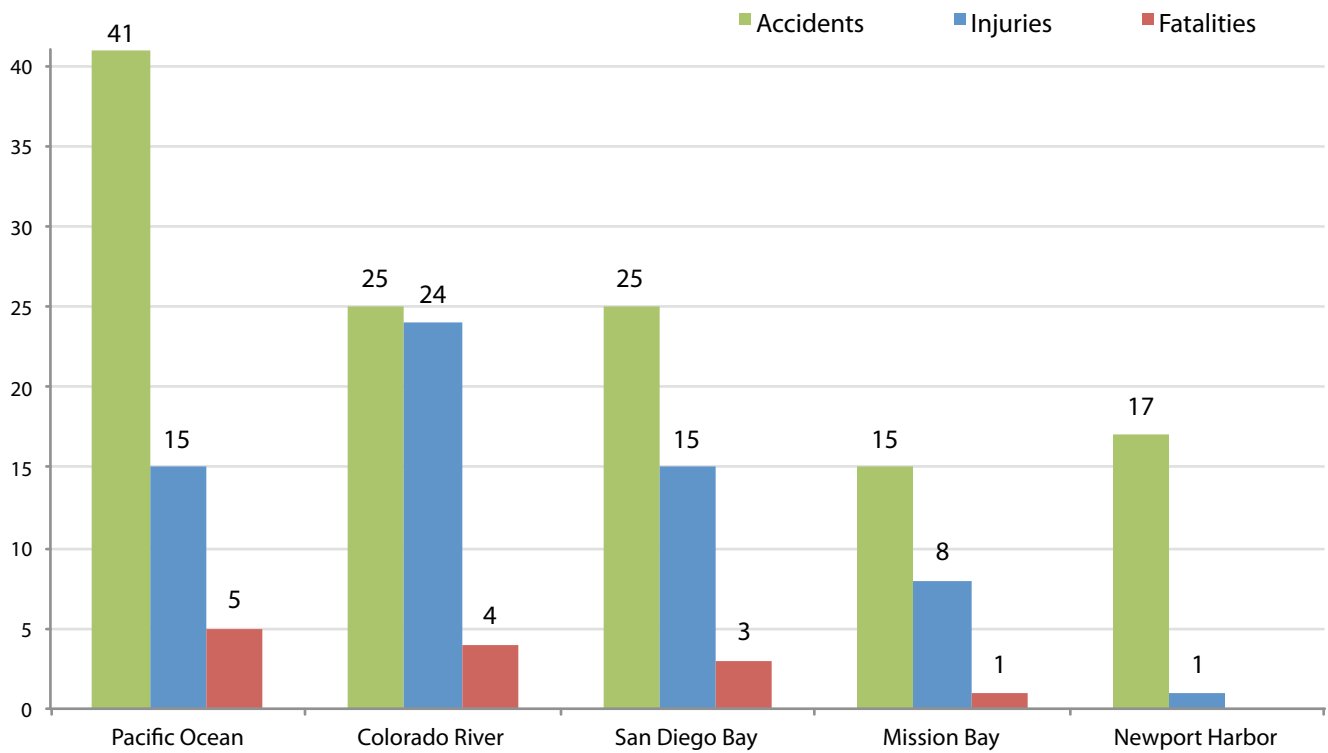

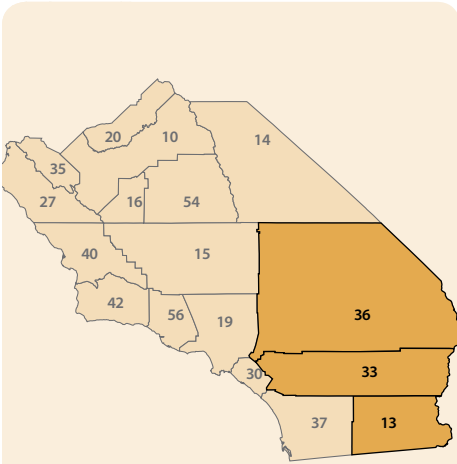
Summary Statistics

The Colorado River forms the border between California and Arizona. San Bernardino, Riverside and Imperial Counties all share a piece of the river.

Accidents on the Colorado River accounted for 5% of all accidents in California, 8% of injuries, and 7% of fatalities.

In 2011, 25 accidents occurred on the Colorado River. These accidents resulted in 24 injuries and 4 fatalities.

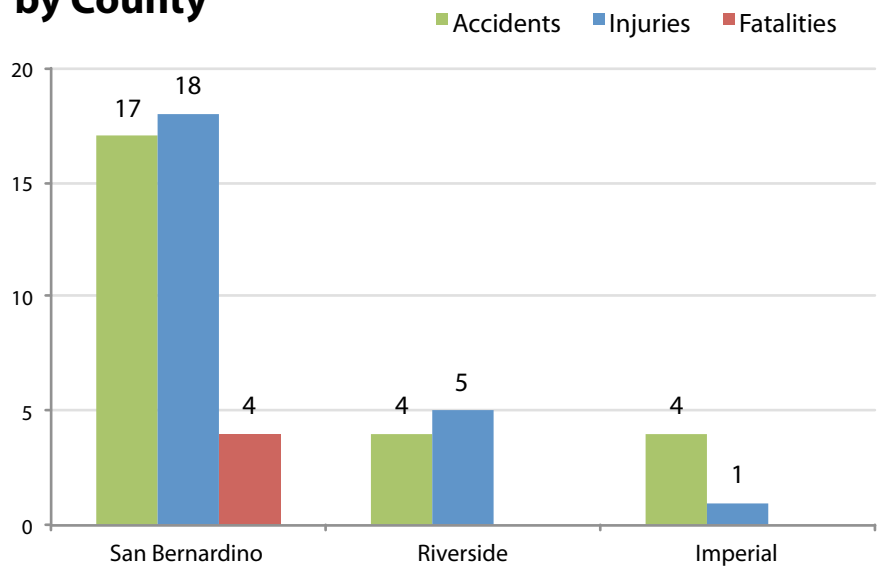
These accidents represented 11% of all accidents in Southern California, 16% of injuries, and 15% of fatalities.

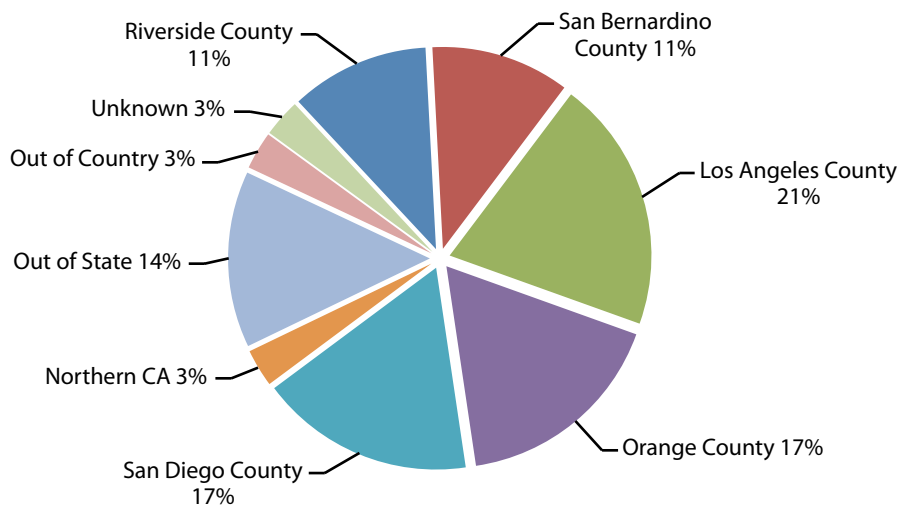

Los Angeles County

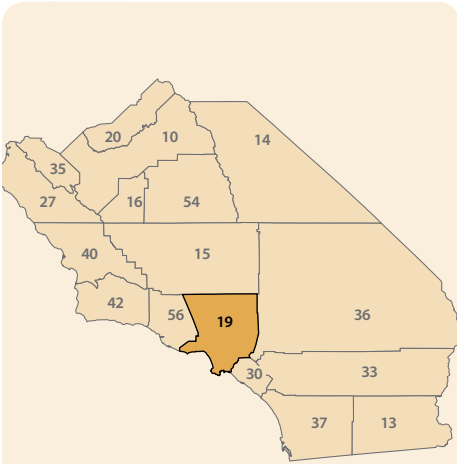
Summary Statistics

As of December 31, 2011, there were 106,307 vessels registered in Los Angeles County—more than any other county—12% of the statewide total.

Thirty-two accidents occurred in Los Angeles County, resulting in 20 injuries, and 7 fatalities.

These accidents represented 14% of all accidents in Southern California, 14% of injuries, and 26% of fatalities.

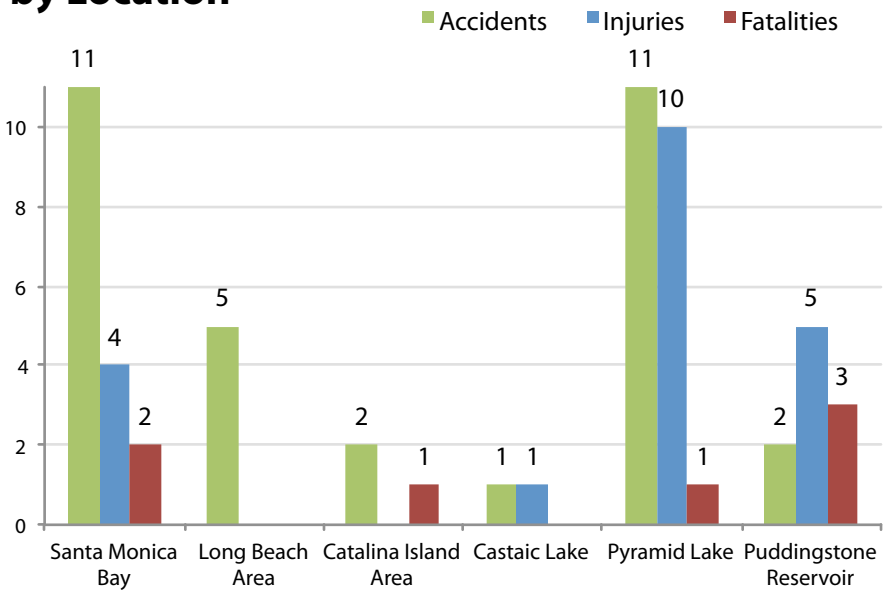
Accidents in Los Angeles County accounted for 6% of accidents in California, 6% of injuries, and 13% of fatalities.



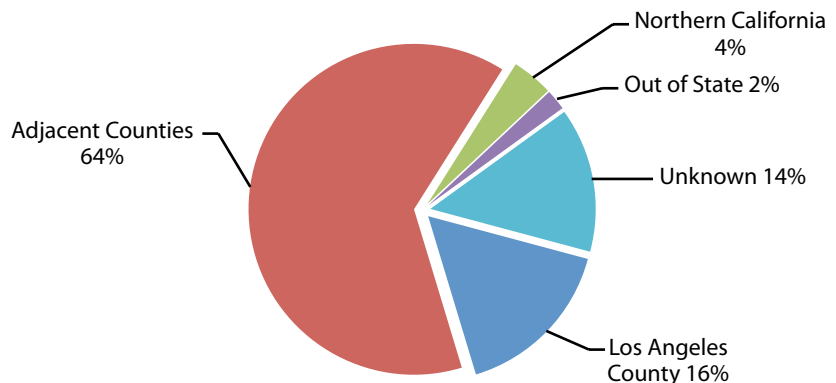

Orange County

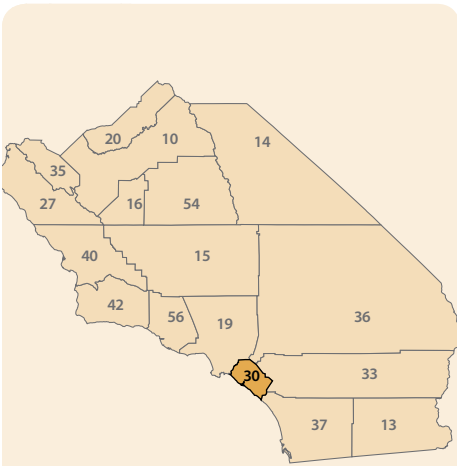
Summary Statistics

As of December 2011, there were 61,270 vessels registered in Orange County, 7% of the statewide total.

Forty-six accidents occurred in Orange County, resulting in 19 injuries and 3 fatalities.

These accidents represented 19% of all accidents in Southern California, 13% of injuries, and 11% of fatalities.

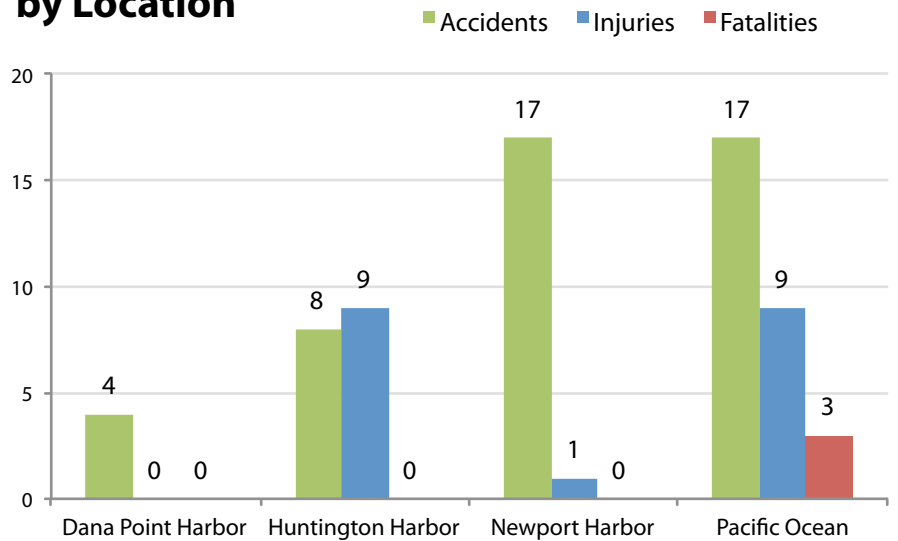
Accidents in Orange County accounted for 9% of accidents in California, 6% of injuries, and 6% of fatalities.



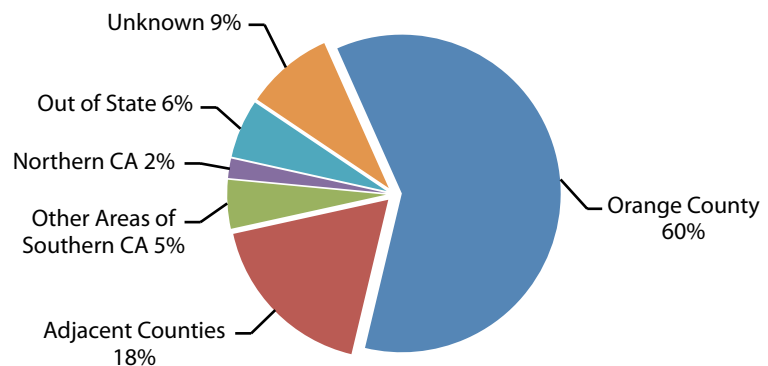

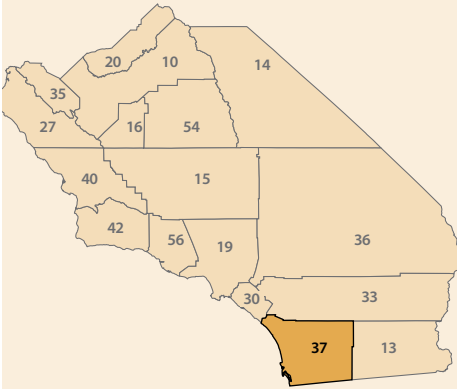
Summary Statistics

As of December 31, 2011, there were 61,598 vessels registered in San Diego County, 7% of the statewide total.

Fifty-three accidents occurred in San Diego County, resulting in 30 injuries and 4 fatalities.

Accidents in San Diego County represented 22% of accidents in Southern California, 21% of injuries, and 15% of fatalities.

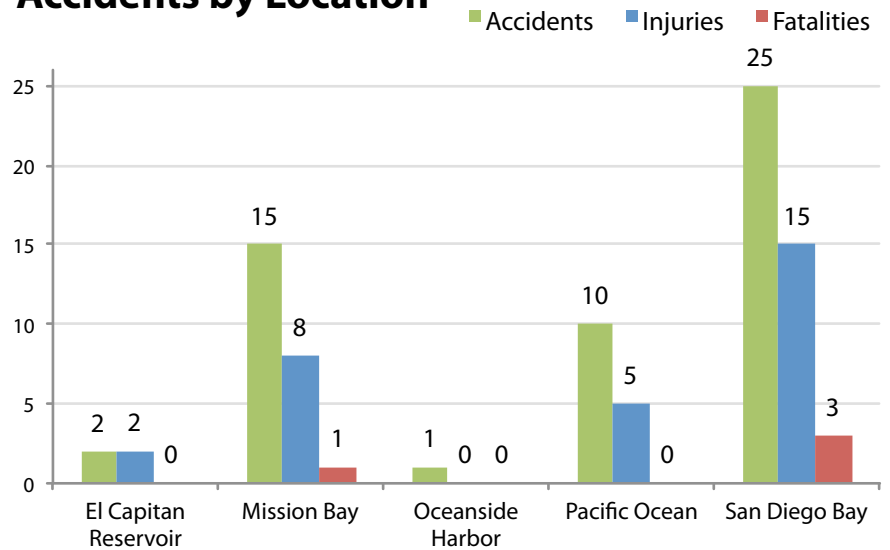
These accidents represented 10% of all accidents in California, 10% of injuries, and 7% of fatalities.



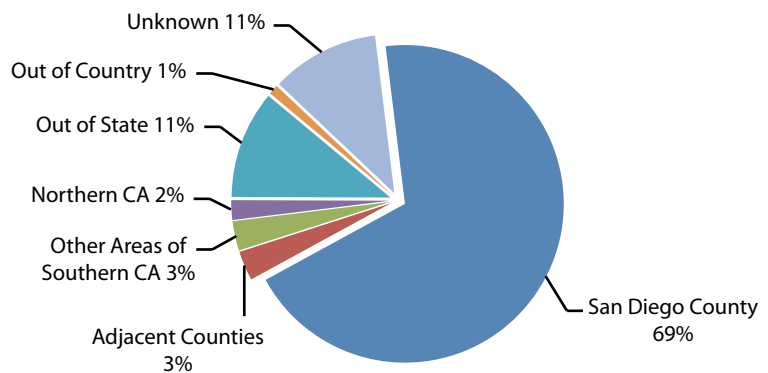
