



The Colorado River forms the border between California and Arizona. San Bernardino, Riverside and Imperial Counties all share a piece of the river.


In 2011, 25 accidents occurred on the Colorado River. These accidents resulted in 24 injuries and 4 fatalities.

These accidents represented 11% of all accidents in Southern California, 16% of injuries, and 15% of fatalities.

Accidents on the Colorado River accounted for 5% of all accidents in California, 8% of injuries, and 7% of fatalities.






As of December 31, 2011, there were 106,307 vessels registered in Los Angeles County—more than any other county—12% of the statewide total.

Thirty-two accidents occurred in Los Angeles County, resulting in 20 injuries, and 7 fatalities. These accidents represented 14% of all accidents in Southern California, 14% of injuries, and 26% of fatalities.

Accidents in Los Angeles County accounted for 6% of accidents in California, 6% of injuries, and 13% of fatalities.




Forty-six accidents occurred in Orange County, resulting in 19 injuries and 3 fatalities.




