
2012 California Recreational Boating Accident General Statistics for Northern California

n 2012, there were 278 boating accidents in Northern California that resulted in 170 injuries and 37 fatalities.

These accidents represent 59% of all accidents statewide, 69% of injuries and 70% of fatalities.

Compared with 2011 accident totals, accidents increased 1%, injuries increased 2% and fatalities increased 37%.


Northern Lakes and the Delta saw increases in accidents. But the San Francisco Bay Area and Northern Rivers saw a decrease in accidents. Accidents on Northern Coastal Waters remained the same from 2011 to 2012.



Northern California Boating Accidents by Location 2012-2012




The Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta had 66 accidents, 34 injuries and 5 fatalities in 2012.







This accounted for 3% of all accidents, 2% of all injuries and 0% of all fatalities in California.




