
2013 California Recreational Boating Accident General Statistics for Northern California

n 2013, there were 294 boating accidents in Northern California that resulted in 172 injuries and 32 fatalities.

These accidents represented 55% of all accidents statewide, 63% of injuries and 84% of fatalities.

Compared with 2012 accident totals, accidents increased 6%, injuries increased 1% and fatalities decreased 14%.

Northern Coastal Waters, Northern Lakes and the San Francisco Bay Area saw increases in accidents. But Northern Rivers and the Delta saw decreases in accidents from 2012-2013.



The Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta had 54 accidents, 22 injuries and 5 fatalities in 2013.

This accounted for 10% of all accidents, 8% of all injuries and 13% of all fatalities in California. The Delta accounted for 18% of accidents, 13% of injuries and 16% of fatalities in Northern California in 2013.







The San Francisco Bay Area accounted for 9% of accidents, 7% of injuries and 9% of fatalities in Northern California in 2013.






