
2014 California Recreational Boating Accident General Statistics for Northern California

n 2014, there were 238 boating accidents in Northern California that resulted in 139 injuries and 27 fatalities.

These accidents represented 45% of all accidents statewide, 53% of injuries and 69% of fatalities.

Compared with 2013 Northern California accident totals, accidents decreased 19%, injuries decreased 19% and fatalities decreased 16%.

Northern Rivers and the San Francisco Bay Area saw increases in accidents. But Northern Coastal Waters, Northern Lakes and the Delta saw decreases in accidents from 2013–2014.




he Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta had 40 accidents, 31 injuries and 2 fatalities in 2014.

The Delta accounted for 17% of accidents, 22% of injuries and 7% of fatalities in Northern California in 2014.







The San Francisco Bay Area had 31 accidents, 9 injuries and 3 fatalities in 2014.


This accounted for 6% of all accidents, 3% of all injuries and 8% of all fatalities in California.


