





Colorado River

The Colorado River forms the border between California and Arizona. San Bernardino, Riverside and Imperial Counties all share a piece of the river.

In 2015, 27 accidents occurred on the Colorado River. These accidents resulted in 28 injuries and 2 fatalities. These accidents represented 10% of all accidents in Southern California, 23% of injuries, and 11% of fatalities.


Accidents on the Colorado River accounted for 5% of all accidents in California, 12% of injuries, and 4% of fatalities.




As of December 31, 2015, there were 91,529 vessels registered in Los Angeles County—more than any other county—12% of the statewide total.

Forty-eight accidents occurred in Los Angeles County, resulting in 15 injuries, and 3 fatalities. These accidents represented 17% of all accidents in Southern California, 12% of injuries, and 16% of fatalities.

Accidents in Los Angeles County accounted for 10% of accidents in California, 6% of injuries, and 6% of fatalities.




Seventy-five accidents occurred in Orange County, resulting in 8 injuries and 3 fatalities.



As of December 31, 2015, there were 56,961 vessels registered in San Diego County, 7% of the statewide total.


Fifty-five accidents occurred in San Diego County, resulting in 29injuries and 3 fatalities.
