

- ▶ 17 applications received
- ▶ 13 unique applicants
- ▶ 12 projects funded
- >\$2.98M awarded



GET YOUR MUSSEL FEE STICKER

The "Mussel Fee Sticker" (also known as the Quagga Sticker) funds statewide quagga and zebra mussel prevention efforts. Recreational boat owners are required to purchase and display a current sticker if their boats will be used in fresh water. This includes inland waterways, rivers, lakes, reservoirs, wetlands and the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta. Failure to properly display the sticker may result in denial of access or citation.

HOW TO GET A MUSSEL FEE STICKER:

- Online at dmv.ca.gov/MusselFee, or in person at a DMV field office, or at your local auto club office such as AAA.

- Properly display the Mussel Fee Sticker on your boat.

The current Mussel Fee Sticker must be displayed on the hull next to the current boat registration sticker. Paying the mussel fee does not entitle vessels to bypass quagga or zebra mussel inspections or fees that may be required by individual reservoir owners or managers.

Applicants can no longer apply for overlapping grant cycles for the same reservoir; they will need to reapply every other year.

This means that if a reservoir is currently covered by a two-year 2023 QZ Grant, that reservoir will not be considered for a QZ Grant until the 2025 solicitation.




2024 Timeline
