Project Summary:

The Division of Boating and Waterways provided \$990,000.00 in grant funding for improvements to the Doran Park Boat Launching Facility at Bodega Bay in Sonoma County. Improvements included: replacement of the existing two-lane boat launching ramp with a new pre-cast single-lane v-grooved ramp; removal and replacement of pile guided boarding float; covering of boarding float piles; installation of new fish cleaning station; relocation of boat washing station; new concrete apron; improvements to the parking lot; installation of an ADA path of travel connecting the boat launch, parking, and fish cleaning areas.

This project will increase boating access and provide enjoyment to boaters for the next 20 years.
