
Project Summary:

The Division of Boating and Waterways provided \$225,000.00 in grant funding for improvements to the Lake Merced Non-Motorized Boat Launching Facility in San Francisco.

Improvements funded by DBW included installation of a new boat dock and a new gangway. Full cost of these two items was \$286,000. The City of San Francisco absorbed the non-DBW-funded portion of these costs. The new features are ADA accessible.

The City of San Francisco spent \$745,342.97, inclusive of DBW funding, to partially fund the above items and fully fund additional site improvements. These additional improvements include new asphalt concrete on the loop roadway into and out of the launch area, concrete curbs and drainage, ADA stall installation adjacent to the launch ramp, signage, lighting, and landscaping.

This project will increase boating access and provide enjoyment to boaters for the next 20 years.


