Form the basis for future, detailed strategies and projects for park operation and improvements.

a dynamic document that is subject to revision as new information is discovered about a park or as public recreation values change.

Each unit of the State Park System should have a CD because it sets the foundation that serves as the basis of all future decisions for a park

#### General Plans

A general plan (GP) is required for a unit of the State Park System before substantial development or a major commitment of resources can occur, and constitutes an environmental impact report (EIR) as required by the Public Resources Code 5002.2

The GP is the primary management guide for a unit.

Defines the purpose, vision, and intent of a unit

Includes goals, guidelines, and broad objectives,

Guides subsequent planning efforts and supports future funding requests in acquisitions, development, and operations
