Official Park Unit/Property Count

- As of January 2024, the California State Park System has an official total of 280 classified units and major unclassified properties.
- Changes in the 22-23 FY included...
 - No units were removed , nor where new units were added to the State Park system.
- The total figure of 280 represents...
 - 265 classified units, and
 - 15 major unclassified properties.
- Not included in the System's official total are the 96 classified units that exist only as portions of a larger classified unit.

Potential Classification of Park Properties

- Scheduled to bring the classification of the Alameda-Tesla Property to the Commission in the Fall.
- Working with internal staff to develop a prioritized list of the remaining 14 unclassified properties
- Process
 - Identify significant natural, cultural, and recreational resources
 - Prepare Inventory of Features (resource summary)
 - Evaluate natural, cultural, recreational, and interpretive opportunities
 - Submit proposed name and classification to the Commission
