- (1) AGENDA: The Commission will proceed through the agenda in order until the agenda is completed or unless the agenda items are reordered by the Chairperson or by majority vote of the Commission. *The Commission may take action following presentation, public comment, and Commission discussion of those matters listed on the agenda.* [Gov. Code §§ 11122, 11125 (a) and (b)].
- (2) PUBLIC COMMENT
 - (a) Public comment for agenda items: The Chairperson will entertain public comment as the Commission takes up agenda items. Individuals attending via Zoom wishing to comment on agenda items should use the "raise hand" feature in Zoom. Individuals attending in person should complete the green Public Comment – Agenda Items form and submit it to the Commission's recording secretary. Comments will be limited to two (2) minutes.
 - (b) Public comment period for items not on the agenda: Individuals attending via Zoom wishing to address the Commission on items not on the agenda during the public comment period should use the "raise hand" feature in Zoom. Individuals attending in person should complete the green Public Comment Agenda Items form and submit it to the Commission's recording secretary. Comments will be limited to two (2) minutes.
 - (c) Written Materials and/or Visual Aids: Members of the public presenting written materials or visual aids as part of their public comments to the Commission are requested to submit material(s) to <u>SPR.Commission@parks.ca.gov</u> no later than Monday, March 4, 2024. The Department is unable to accept files larger than 25MB. The Department reserves the right to decline to show photographs that violate personal privacy (photos without a release from person/people shown in photograph) or other valid reason in the opinion of the Department and its legal counsel.

(3) CONSENT CALENDAR: The Commission may approve items on the Consent Calendar in a single motion without public comment. Any person may request that an item be removed from the Consent Calendar, to present public comment. Individuals attending via Zoom shall make such request by using the "raise hand" feature in Zoom. Individuals attending in person shall make such request by completing the green Public Comment – Agenda Items form and submitting it to the Commission's recording secretary. If such a request is made, the item(s) shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and heard by the Commission as described in (2)(a) and (2)(c) above. The Commission welcomes comments on Consent Calendar items following approval. Any person wishing to address the Commission on a Consent Calendar item, but not wishing to remove it from the Consent Calendar, shall follow the above-mentioned process for providing public comment as described in (2)(a) and (2)(c) above. The Commission will hear the comments after approval of the Consent Calendar.
