

- 6. San Elijo (beta camping)





Interim Manual Fulfillment Process

- Background: Between August 1, 2017 R2S2 Go-Live and March 2018, many of the parks scheduled for R2S2 in one of the five rollout waves will have to use an Interim Manual Fulfillment process until they receive their R2S2 equipment. I will forward the Interim Manual Fulfillment process MS Word document for your reference.
- Action: Printer Test and Survey Access a Report on R2S2 Platform and Print on Existing Equipment (RA or DPR)



This document can be used as a temporary pass for 14 days following your purchase. You should receive your pass in the mail within 14 days of your purchase. If you do not receive your pass within this time frame, please call 1-800-444-7275.

To use your temporary pass, print this document and fold it in half. Please bring your temporary pass and required valid photo identification (interim/ temporary not accepted) with you when you visit California State Parks. Please display your temporary pass on the passenger side of your vehicle dashboard.

Oversized vehicles are described as 25 feet or over in length or 9 feet or wider in width may be charged an Oversized Vehicle fee (OHV) equal to and in addition to the park's vehicle day use fee. A vehicle pulling a trailer will also be considered an oversized vehicle.
