Reserve America (RA) Blackout Period

- When: Will occur July 26th (Midnight) to July 31st (Midnight)
- Why: R2S2 Project will need to extract the most up to date advanced reservations from RA prior to go-live (8/1)
- What: All parks will continue to have access to Resource Manager in RA to run reports (Daily In/Out) and DPR 453s on Laser printers. Parks will no longer have access to Field Manager during this time.

*Please note-Hearst will continue to have access to both Venue Manager (for same day ticket reservations) and Resource Manager.





IMF Overview

Between August 1, 2017 and February 28, 2018, parks currently using Reserve America (RA) will use the **Interim Manual Fulfillment Process** to manage reservations and sales using the equipment currently at their locations. The new **R2S2 Report Portal** will support the IMF Process.
