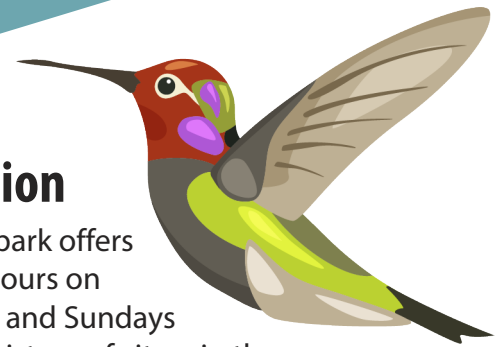

## Day Trip Option

This state historic park offers one-hour guided tours on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays that focus on the history of citrus in the area—a history that contributed to California’s legacy and lingering image as the land of sunshine and opportunity.
