DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S POSTED ORDER No. 021-25-680-272

**Carnegie State Vehicle Recreation Area
Public Water Usage**

1. In conjunction with the California Governor Executive Order B-18-12, the public use of park unit supplied potable or non-potable water within Carnegie State Vehicle Recreation Area shall be restricted within the day use areas and concession facilities as directed within this order.
 - A. Potable or non-potable water use by the public is prohibited for the purposes of filling a recreational vehicle water storage tank, travel trailer water storage tank, any similar vehicle or utility trailer water storage tank including storage devices exceeding (1) one U.S. gallon capacity.
 - B. Potable or non-potable water use by the public is prohibited for the purposes of vehicle washing or off-highway vehicle washing. Cleaning a vehicle windshield for the safe operation of a vehicle by the driver is authorized.
 - C. Potable or non-potable water use by the public is prohibited for any other purposes beyond personal consumption or medical emergencies from any park unit provided water outlet or spigot.
2. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore, California 94550.
3. Nothing herein shall affect any existing concession contract, private contract, or property rights.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
