DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S POSTED ORDER No. 022-25-680-272

**Carnegie State Vehicle Recreation Area
Vehicle, Equipment & Pedestrian Use**

1. To ensure the safety of persons and property and to prevent resource damage, the following activities are prohibited at Carnegie State Vehicle Recreation Area:
2. No person shall operate a motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle with traction enhancing devices such as:
 - A. Paddle tires
 - B. Tires with metal paddles, studs, chains.
 - C. Any metal paddles that attach to the tires.
3. No person shall operate a bicycle, moped, motorized bicycle, or vehicle of any kind, including an off-highway vehicle, as deemed in section 38006 of the California Vehicle Code (CVC), upon any area of the trails only zone, other than on an approved or designated trail, based upon the system established by the District Superintendent or Designee. A vehicle may cross a closed trail while being operated lawfully upon an open trail in that area. Bicycles may operate North of Corral Hollow Creek Closure area within the valley floor (general day use areas, camping area, and main park road).
4. No person shall operate a bicycle, moped, motorized bicycle, or vehicle of any kind, including an off-highway vehicle, as deemed in CVC 38006, 38319 or within any area that is fenced or posted as closed. Driving through a damaged fence into a closed area when that fence should reasonably be considered to be enclosing a prohibited area constitutes a violation of this order.
5. No person shall operate a vehicle other than a motorcycle, as defined in CVC 400, or all-terrain vehicle as defined in CVC 111, South of the Corral Hollow Creek closure, with the following exceptions:
 - A. Employees of the Department of Parks and Recreation.
 - B. Employees or Representatives of the Connolly Ranch may drive on the SRI Road easement when necessary.
 - C. Companies delivering materials and contractors working on approved projects within the unit.
 - D. Cal-Fire emergency response personnel and equipment.
 - E. Other vehicles, equipment, and personnel approved by California State Parks representatives.

6. No person shall operate a bicycle, moped, motorized bicycle, or vehicle of any kind, including an off-highway vehicle as deemed in CVC 38006, upon or across the paved SRI Road, or within the area enclosed by the boundary fence for the SRI corridor, with the following exceptions:
 - A. Employees of the California Department of Parks and Recreation.
 - B. Employees and authorized representatives of the Connolly Ranch Inc., or authorized guests traveling to or from their property, in accordance with the easement granted for their use.
 - C. Off-road vehicles lawfully riding within Carnegie SVRA may ride across the paved SRI Road only at a designated crossing, at an angle of approximately 90 degrees from the roadway to the continuation of the OHV trail on the opposite side of the road and remaining at all times within the designated and painted crossing.

7. No person shall operate a motorized vehicle along Corral Hollow Creek outside the five (5) clearly marked and posted crossing areas:
 - A. West Pottery Loop, Maintenance Bridge, Middle Track Flats, Los Osos Road, and SRI Road.
 - B. All vehicles crossing the creek must stay within the designated crossing zones at all times while crossing the creek.
 - C. Vehicle operation south of the creek is restricted to the 4x4 area adjacent to the motocross track. Access to that facility will be from the crossing at the SRI Road.

8. Pedestrian access is prohibited on all trails and tracks of Carnegie State Vehicle Recreation Area. Pedestrians may only hike on the Valley Floor North of Corral Hollow Creek or upon the Main Park Road.

9. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore, California 94550.

10. Nothing herein shall affect any existing concession contract, private contract, or property rights.

11. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
