DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S ORDER No. 412-19-001

**Fremont Peak State Park  
Hours of Use**

1. The day use parking lots of Fremont Peak State Park are hereby closed to public use, entry, or occupancy from ½ hour after sunset to 8:00 a.m. daily except for Department-approved activities related to astronomy and stargazing. The standard used to define sunset is the current tide table for Monterey Bay, National Ocean Survey Tables, U. S. Department of Commerce. Astronomers may park and set up equipment in the southwest (upper) parking lot and the Coulter group picnic areas only; all other areas are off limits. Astronomers must be actively viewing with their equipment; any other activities are subject to citation and/or eviction. The Vehicle Parking Fee is applied to approved astronomy activities in the park and must be paid upon arrival.
2. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private, contractual, and residential or property rights.
3. Exceptions to this order may only be granted by a DPR-approved Special Event Permit or Film Permit or in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore California 94550.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed to be in derogation of other provisions of law.
