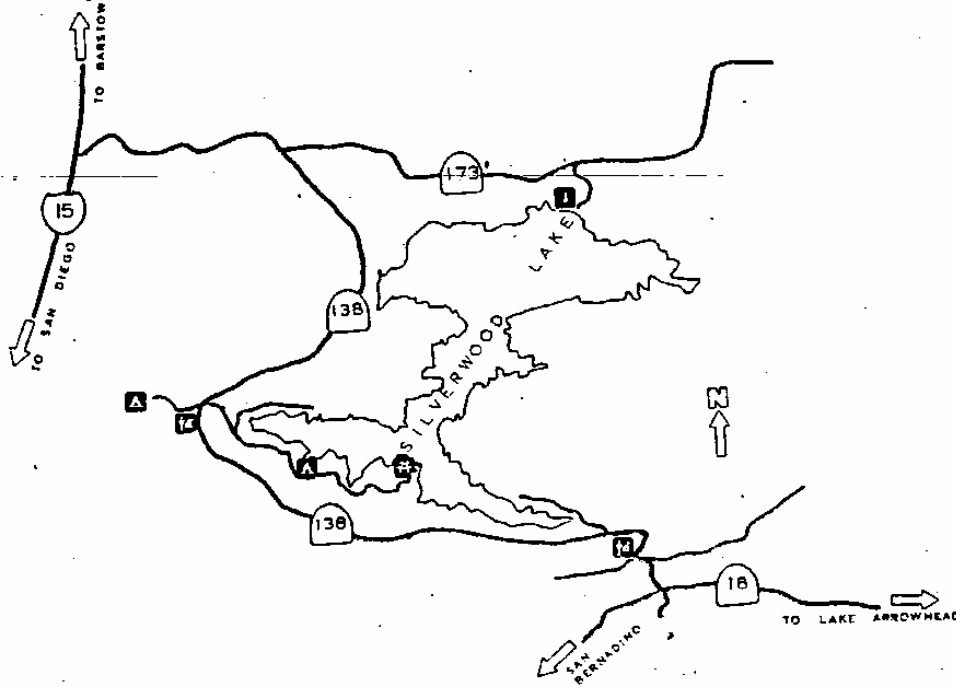


## California State Park System

# Silverwood Lake State Recreation Area

Silverwood Lake is located in the San Bernardino Mountains at the edge of the high Mojave Desert at an elevation of 3,350 feet. Boating, fishing, waterskiing, jetskiing, hiking, bicycling and swimming are all popular activities. Several picnic areas surround the lake, including three which are accessible only by boat. Rangers lead activities such as nature walks, Junior Rangers, campfire programs and winter boat tours to view Bald eagles.
