 Effective immediately, for the security, safeguarding, and preservation of resources, the area of Emma Wood State Beach-North Beach Campground, as described below, is hereby declared prohibited to vehicles and overnight camping. The area closed to vehicle entry and overnight camping by this order is limited to:

All portions of the Emma Wood State Beach-North Beach Campground, as **posted**, during dangerously high tides, at or exceeding 5.5 feet, and for the subsequent cleanup and repairs.

- 2. Only those vehicles authorized by the District Superintendent or his/her designee may enter this area. Only those persons authorized by the District Superintendent or his/her designee may remain after sunset in this area.
- 3. Exceptions to this closure order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Channel Coast District, 911 San Pedro Street, Ventura, CA 93001.
- 4. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.
- 5. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
