The area closed to entry by this order is:

All water impounded in and flowing from the Estuary is closed to all swimming, wading, flotation device use, boating, kayaking, or other water entry.

- 2. Exceptions to this closure order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Channel Coast District, 911 San Pedro Street, Ventura, CA 93001.
- 3. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.
- 4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
