- 2. During this period of closure, all visitor traffic shall be confined to the multi-use trail and non-vegetated/sandy portions of the beach.
- 3. Exceptions to this closure order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Channel Coast District, 911 San Pedro Street, Ventura, CA 93001.
- 4. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.
- 5. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of others provisions of law.




