Hike & Bike Regulations

1. Effective immediately, the following conditions shall apply to the "Hike and Bike" camping facilities located at **El Capitan State Beach, Gaviota State Park, and Refugio State Beach**:
 - All applicable fees shall be paid before occupying Hike and Bike campsites.
 - Check in time shall be 2:00 PM. Check out time, (removal of all persons and property), shall be at 12:00 PM on the day due out.
 - Individual stays shall be **limited to two nights**, which must be followed by vacating the park for forty-eight, (48) hours, from 12:00 PM of the check out day to 2:00 PM of the second day following.
 - The **Maximum Occupancy** by the same persons and/or equipment is limited to a total **of ten (10) days in any calendar year per park (based on the conditions listed above.)**
2. Exceptions to this order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Channel Coast District, 911 San Pedro Street, Ventura, CA 93001.
3. Nothing in this order shall affect private contract or property rights.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
