## Dumpster Closure

1. Effective immediately, to provide for the security, safeguarding, and preservation of resources and public safety, the trash receptacles within the CHANNEL COAST DISTRICT are hereby declared a prohibited area.

No person other than an authorized solid waste service provider shall remove any solid waste or recyclables from solid waste receptacle within the Channel Coast District.

No other person other than a solid waste service provider authorized by the State of California, shall remove a container from the location where the container was placed for storage or collection from all Channel Coast District Units, or remove any solid waste from any container, or move the container from the location where it was stored.
2. Exceptions to this closure order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Channel Coast District, 911 San Pedro Street, Ventura, CA 93001.
3. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
