1. The Gaviota Pier sustained severe damage during a storm event. Due to safety concerns from that damage the pier at **Gaviota State Park** will remain closed to all pedestrian/vehicle/vessel traffic and other usage, except for Department personnel and vehicles, or their contractors, carrying out official business.
2. Exceptions to this closure order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Channel Coast District, 911 San Pedro Street, Ventura, CA 93001.
3. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
